Personal appearance is not only a reflection of the individual, but also of the Christ-like environment. Therefore, participants have a responsibility to wear clothing that projects a Christ-like attitude of pride in self, church, and the community in which we serve. Participants are expected to wear appropriate clothing that is neat, clean, and in good taste.

- 1. Shirts and blouses must have sleeves. Off the shoulder garments are not allowed.
- 2. Tights, jeggings, yoga pants, leggings, or any spandex type material will not be allowed alone or as pants. If worn, they must be worn with an over layer, such as pants, shorts, or skirts, which are no shorter than the width of a dollar bill above the knee.
- 3. See-through clothing and clothing that has rips, tears, or frays to the point of creating holes is not permitted. Also, low cut blouses which show any cleavage are not allowed. All undergarments are to be covered. All midriffs are to be covered.
- 4. No clothing which displays profanity, suggestive phrases, alcohol, tobacco, or drug advertisements shall be worn.
- 5. You can dress appropriately for various athletic activities on campus.
