This year marks the 21<sup>st</sup> year that the churches of the Hephzibah and Kilpatrick Baptist Association will be assisting Bluefield, West Virginia area churches in the work of the ministry. We have the opportunity to serve at least 6 Churches in the Bluefield/Princeton area of Virginia/West Virginia area churches this July. We do this work in response to the invitation of these churches and the willingness of folks in our association to volunteer. These are churches that are at a time where they cannot do the ministries we are helping with on their own and are greatly blessed by the boost a team of volunteers give them. While every year is a little different, we will again be conducting Vacation Bible Schools, doing construction work, having community cook outs, specialized worship services plus whatever else they need as our Lord leads. We are amazed at how you work together to carry out this ministry and we trust that you will join together again in this great work.

**Trip Dates:** July 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>, 2024

**Deposit/Registration Deadline: June 3, 2024 and \$50 deposit due with registration.**

**Total Cost: \$260 Non-A/C or \$290 A/C Dorm**

\*AC dorm priority will be given to senior adults and those with medical needs. The remainder of the rooms will be first come, first served with all monies and paperwork turned in to KBA.

\*\*All participants must provide their own linens for the week\*\* **We can accept the monies in smaller increments between now and June 10th to meet your budget needs.**

**Deposit Due:** \$50 (non-refundable)

**Balance Due by** June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024

**Pastor, please help by communicating with your congregation:**

1. Ask someone at your church to be your point of contact for the West Virginia Lead Team and contact Rev. Tim Batchelor to learn more about this role – this is critical for communication.
2. List the West Virginia Mission Trip in your church bulletin and your newsletters each week.
3. Announce the trip from the pulpit often, encouraging a small group to represent your church ON MISSION!

**Your church can participate in the following ways:**

1. Encourage others and pray specifically for workers - the fields are ready for harvest, but the workers are few.
2. Donate funds for Fuel and School Supplies - you may set a goal, like you would for Lottie Moon or Annie Armstrong.
3. Adopt a WV/VA VBS or construction site and provide some funding to cover those expenses.
4. Make jumpers or salvation dolls for the children in West Virginia.
5. Make cards of encouragement for those in our Association who are going ON MISSION! More information will be given about this later. Please let one of the Ministry Assistants at KBA know if your church or small group is interested in doing this.
6. Invite a Mission Team Leader to speak to your church to help promote participation. There are team leaders in both associations who can do a short announcement presentation during a worship service or a longer presentation. We aim to fit your schedule and needs.

- Background Check Consent Form – 18+ years of age (Valid for 3 years)
